### OUR SCHOOL

Deira International School (DIS) was founded in September 2005, as a co-educational day school offering instruction from Foundation Stage to Year 13 with a current enrollment of over 1600 students. The student body comprises of more than 80 nationalities which enables the school to embody a truly international feel, whilst providing a British-based curriculum.

The 80,000 space sq. m. facility is located in Dubai Festival City, a suburb of Dubai, United Arab Emirates. It is a purpose-built facility and amongst the largest in the Middle East.

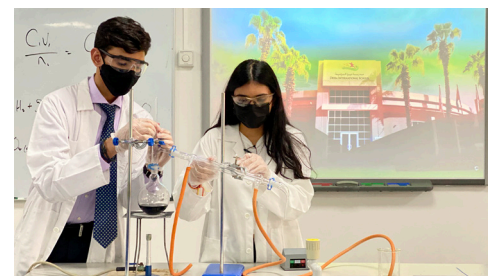
Deira International School is owned and operated as a non-profit school by the Al-Futtaim, one of the largest and most respected corporations in the lower gulf region.

Deira International School is authorized by the International Baccalaureate Organization as an IB World School.

The local inspectorate, the KHDA, have rated our school in 2019 as 'Very Good' with many outstanding features'.

### THE SCHOOL YEAR

The school year comprises of three terms running from September to December, January to March and April to June.



### EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (ECAs)

There is an extensive after-school programme at DIS offering courses ranging from Ballet to the Duke of Edinburgh Award and Model United Nations. Student development is not limited to the classroom as students are encouraged to participate in the many extracurricular activities offered by the school. Field Trips are organised by our specialist Outdoor Education Teacher. Extracurricular sports include boys' and girls' football, basketball, rugby, tennis and swimming. A vocal and instrumental programme offers a broad range of musical study. Chorus, dance, performing arts programmes are also offered along with other academic and non-academic programmes.

DIS has an active Parents' Association, Student Representative Council and School Board of Trustees.

\* Please note due to the pandemic all school based ECAs had been cancelled in 2020-21 academic year. Reopening in September 2021, KHDA allowed ECAs to return.

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to complete a two year pre-university programme of study in Years 12 and 13 (USA equivalent of Grades 11 and 12).

We offer three International qualification curricula: The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP), IB Courses, and the IB Career Related Programme (IBCP). Students must fulfill the requirements of the International Baccalaureate Organisation to graduate. IBCP students are also required to undertake work experience with local organisations.

Examinations are marked externally and are taken in May of Year 13. Students graduate in the month of June and receive their final results in July.

## GRADING SYSTEM

### National Curriculum Levels

The English National Curriculum levels are used throughout the school from Key Stage 1 to 3. Detailed explanations of these are available on the QCDA website <http://curriculum.qcda.gov.uk/>

### International General Certificate of Secondary Education

IGCSE grades are marked using an eight-point grade scale: A\*, A, B, C, D, E, F and G. Grade A\* is awarded for the highest level of achievement, and grade G indicates minimum satisfactory performance. A U denotes 'Ungraded'. Students must obtain a minimum of 6 A\* - C grades at IGCSE to qualify for a place on the IB Diploma Programme and a minimum of 3 C grades to qualify for the IBCP. ### International Baccalaureate

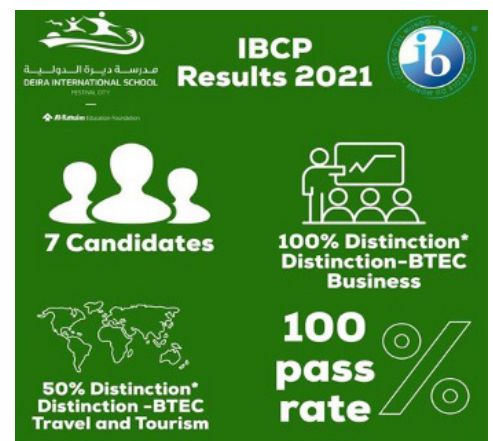
## CURRICULUM AND DISTANCE LEARNING PROGRAM

Deira International School follows the National Curriculum of England, enhanced by the best features of international education, particularly the philosophy of the International Baccalaureate Organisation.

The school is fully authorised to offer the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) and the IB Career-Related Programme (IBCP). The school is also a Cambridge IGCSE, BTEC and Edexcel examination centre.

The language of instruction is English and there is an extensive foreign language programme in Arabic, French and Spanish. Specialised support is provided to students for whom English is a second language, students who are Gifted & Talented, and those with mild learning difficulties.

Due to government regulations, DIS students started their distance learning program in Term 3 of 2020. In September 2020, students had the option to continue with digital learning or return to campus. The distance learning program mimicked a normal school day with students receiving the same amount of teaching and learning per subject. Lessons were delivered through Microsoft Teams using live lessons and other teaching and learning tools such as OneNote. Assessments continued digitally utilizing Turnitin to check authenticity of submission. As of September 2021, DIS held onsite mock examinations for IB students and all students are required to come back to campus for Onsite Learning from 3 October 2021. Exemptions may be requested for students with high risk medical conditions who may be able to continue with Distance Learning only per the approval received from Dubai Health Authority.

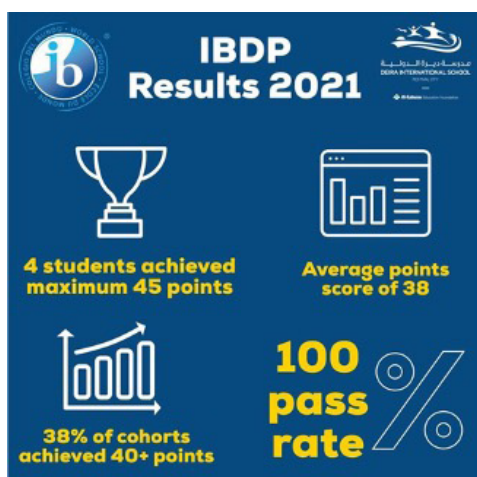

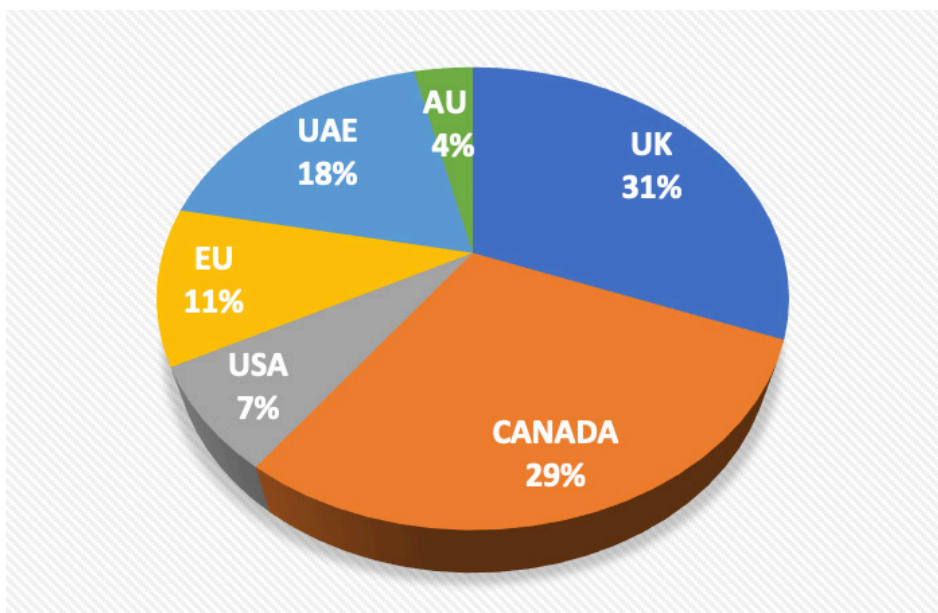
