OUR SCHOOL

Deira International School (DIS) was founded in September 2005, as a co-educational day school offering instruction from Foundation Stage to Year 13 with a current enrollment of over 1600 students. The student body comprises of more than 80 nationalities which enables the school to embody a truly international feel, whilst providing a British-based curriculum.

The 80,000 space sq. m. facility is located in Dubai Festival City, a suburb of Dubai, United Arab Emirates. It is a purpose-built facility and amongst the largest in the Middle East.

Deira International School is owned and operated as a non-profit school by the Al-Futtaim, one of the largest and most respected corporations in the lower gulf region.

Deira International School is authorized by the International Baccalaureate Organization as an IB World School.

The local inspectorate, the KHDA, have rated our school as 'Outstanding' in 2023. This rating places DIS as one of the top secondary institutions within the Emirate of Dubai, with only fifteen schools receiving this distinction at the time of publication

THE SCHOOL YEAR

The school year comprises of three terms running from September to December, January to March and April to June.





EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (ECAs)

There is an extensive after-school programme at DIS offering courses ranging from Ballet to the Duke of Edinburgh Award and Model United Nations. Student development is not limited to the classroom as students are encouraged to participate in the many extracurricular activities offered by the school. Field Trips are organised by our specialist Outdoor Education Teacher. Extracurricular sports include boys' and girls' football, basketball, rugby, tennis and swimming. A vocal and instrumental programme offers a broad range of musical study. Chorus, dance, performing arts programmes are also offered along with other academic and non-academic programmes.

DIS has an active Parents' Association, Student Representative Council and School Board of Trustees.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to complete a two year preuniversity programme of study in Years 12 and 13 (USA equivalent of Grades 11 and 12).

We offer three International qualification curricula: The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP), IB Courses, and the IB Career Related Programme (IBCP) . Students must fulfill the requirements of the International Baccalaureate Organisation to graduate. IBCP students are also required to undertake work experience with local organisations.

Examinations are marked externally and are taken in May of Year 13. Students graduate in the month of June and receive their final results in July.

International General Certificate of Secondary Education


IGCSE grades are marked using an eight-point grade scale: A*, A, B, C, D, E, F and G. Grade A* is awarded for the highest level of achievement, and grade G indicates minimum satisfactory performance. A U denotes 'Ungraded'. Students must obtain a minimum of 6 A* - C grades at IGCSE to qualify for a place on the IB Diploma Programme and a minimum of 3 C grades to qualify for the IBCP. 
